## JCHA Minutes from August 9, 2006

Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by President Mike Lutz. Roll call of the board showed all present. Guests were introduced. He thanked the refreshment and door prize donors.

Motion was made and approved to accept the July minutes as printed in the newsletter.

Treasurer report, presented by Gina Ryan stated we currently have \$3,812.18 in the checking, \$4,438.16 in savings, \$42.56 petty cash and \$2,000 in the Joann Pool Trail Enhancement Fund for a total of \$10,292.90. Report was approved. The final breakdown on the Lily Glen event was \$658 profit. Question was asked about the LINGO Ride, but no one could remember who the winners were.

Colleen Low, Sunshine Committee Member, reported she didn't send any cards this month. No one knew of any cards that needed to be sent. We sang Happy Birthday to Carol Murray.

Mike Lutz reported on the Bear Creek Equestrian Greenway cleanup day. There were only a handful of volunteers, but they got most of the club's section of the trail done.

Colleen Low reported the Quinn Meadows campout was great. There was a problem with the road being closed due to fire but everyone went around through Sunriver or Bend. The camp was fine, the trails were open. They had a nice potluck on Saturday night.

Debbie organized the group for the High Lakes Trail Dedication ride on Aug 5<sup>th</sup>. 15 riders attended. This trail was constructed on the snowmobile trail and is 4.5 miles long. There are possibilities for loops.

Bill Konantz reported he will be meeting with the Bureau of Reclamation about Lily Glen this month. Also, a beautiful 4x8 sign was painted by Shari Woods for the Lily Glen Park. It tells about the rebuild plan and how to donate to the cause. Bill requested help in putting the sign up at the entrance. Tommy R. volunteered to help.

Karen did not have any news on the Chrissy Park area.

Karen will lead a ride on Saturday, Aug 12 from Willow Prairie to Fish Lake for lunch. Meet at the Old Farmhouse (formally Road Runner) at 8:30.

Karen reminded everyone of the Coast Campout over Labor Day. Call her by Aug. 23 if you plan to attend.

Debbie brought up the Fall Gymkhana set for October 7<sup>th</sup> at the Krouse Barn at the fairgrounds. She read the flyer from last year and everyone agreed to do the same. She suggested we also have Gift Certificates from the Horse Blanket again as High Point awards. The Brostad's agreed to donate to the awards again this year also. Motion was made and approved to purchase gift certificates.

Debbie told the group about the Northwest Trail Riders annual October Poker Ride on the beach to be held on October 15<sup>th</sup>. Many members will go over on the 14<sup>th</sup>, ride the redwoods and camp at the fairgrounds.

Scott said the Sheriff Posse is holding a Car, truck horse trailer Wash at Premier West Bank in Central Point On Saturday, Aug 12<sup>th</sup>.

Carol D. asked if the club would like to the Horse Show again next year. Motion was made and approved to do the show and have Carol set the date, time and place.

Motion was made to hold the Buckaroo Drawing (Meeting Incentive) before the 50/50 and door prize. Motion was dropped without a second.

50/50 winner was Diane Schofield and the Door Prize winner was Don Ferris. Buckaroo Drawing worth \$40 was Cindy Hill, but she was not present.
