

CUNEO CREEK HORSE CAMP

Hwy 101 – Weott, CA

Directions

Take I-5 to Grants Pass. Take Hwy 199 towards Crescent City (about 80 miles). Go south on Hwy 101, through Eureka (about 120 miles). From Highway 101, take the Honeydew/South Fork exit just before Weott. Turn right at the intersection at the bottom of the off ramp. You are now on the Mattole Road. Drive about eight miles on this road and you will see the Cuneo Creek Horse Camp sign. Turn right and drive in the entrance road until you arrive at the campground. (All paved except for the last ¼ mile.)

Facilities

Owned and operated by Humboldt Redwoods State Park, there are two group sites and five individual sites. All have pipe corrals. There are restrooms, coin showers, water troughs, manure bins and hitching rails. Each site has fire rings, tables and potable water. The camp is located right on Cuneo Creek which is a tributary to Bull Creek.

Fees

Group sites are \$100 and \$90 per night. Individual sites are \$20 per night. Group sites and two of the individual sites may be reserved by calling Reserve America at (800) 444-7275.

Description

There is approximately 50 miles of horse and hiking trails. This area is fairly steep but the trails and old roads are in excellent condition. Most climb to the top of the ridges for beautiful views. Summer activities at nearby Albee Creek Campground include evening campfire programs, guided nature walks, and Junior Ranger programs for children ages 7 to 12 years. Temperatures can hit high 90's in the summer.
