

# FOURMILE LAKE HORSE CAMP

Between Medford and Klamath Falls

## Directions

From I-5 go east out of Medford on Crater Lake Hwy to White City. Go east on Hwy 140 about 36 miles to Fourmile Lake Road (east of Fish Lake). Turn north and proceed 6 miles on the graveled road to the campground. The horse camp area is to the left at the far end of the campground.

## Facilities

A few older campsites were reconstructed as horse camping sites and some new ones were created make 11 horse camp sites. There are picnic tables, fire rings, water pump and outhouses. Three sites have corrals, a 4-horse in one and two with 2-horse, but you can tie to your trailer or high line in the trees in the other campsites.

## Fees

Sites are \$9.00 per night. It is first-come first-serve, no reservations.

## Description

The trails are well maintained and most lead into the Sky Lakes Wilderness. You can do a long loop all the way around Fourmile Lake (about 5 hours) or just short trips to several lakes. Pick up a Winema National Forest map and the Sky Lakes Wilderness Map prior to going.

## Notes

Do not ride on the access roads through the campground. Only ride on the designated trails.

This area is popular for mosquitoes until late July/August so come prepared.
