

SILVER CREEK MARSH

Silver Lake, Oregon

Directions

From Medford take Hwy 140 43 miles to West Side Rd/Rocky Point. Turn left and go 17 miles and the road becomes Sevenmile Road. Go another 4.7 miles and turn right on Weed Rd, then turn left on Loosley Rd. Next, turn right onto Hwy 62 and go 5.3 miles and turn left on OR-422. In 3 miles turn left onto Hwy 97. Go north on Hwy 97 about 19 miles to Silver Lake Road (FS 76). This road is about 55 miles long and will connect into Hwy 31. (It does change names a few times, but just follow the signs to Silver Lake.) At Hwy 31 turn right and go about $\frac{3}{4}$ mile and turn right on County Road 4-11. Stay on this paved road for 10 miles and you will see the campground/trailhead entrance sign.

Facilities

There are several camp sites, but only one loop for equestrians with 6 sites. Each site has a table, fire ring and two sites have horse corrals. There are many trees to highline. Horse water in the creek or from the hand pump. Garbage cans available.

Fees

\$6 per site per night. The camp is maintained from May through November, snow permitting.

Description

This camp is located along Silver Creek and a trailhead for the Fremont National Recreation Trail. You can travel either direction on the trail and also connect into the Yamsay Mountain trail system.
