

TWIN PONDS TRAIL #3715

Directions to Trailhead

This trail can be accessed by taking Hwy 140 to USFS Road 3661 to Fourmile Lake. Continue up the graveled road to the Fourmile Lake campground. Turn left and park in the staging area near the horse camping section of the campground. Parking permits are required.

Length of Ride

Twin Ponds Trail is 2.5 mile in length. It connects to the Pacific Crest Trail at this point, so you may continue riding north or south for as long as you like. This trail has heavy use from June to October.

Basic Description of the Trail

From the trailhead, at an elevation of 5700', the Twin Ponds Trail follows the route of the 1864 Fort Klamath-Jacksonville Military Wagon Road, winding through a relatively gentle, rolling terrain supporting forest stands dominated by lodgepole pines. It passes by the Twin Pond Lakes and Summit Lake. If you take the Pacific Crest Trail northward, a loop ride is possible via the Badge Lake Trail (approximately 5 hours). This makes an adventurous day ride from the Fourmile Lake Campground.
