

WILD MARE HORSE CAMP

North Bend, Oregon

Directions

From Medford go north on I-5 to exit 119 near Roseburg. Follow signs for OR-42 to the coast for about 72 miles. Turn north on Hwy 101 and go through North Bend (about 9 miles). About 1.5 miles past North Bend follow the sign to the Horsfall Dunes and Beach. This camp is about 1.5 miles down Horsfall Road.

Facilities

There are 12 two-horse sites situated on a loop road. Big rigs may have trouble negotiating the loop, but could back into one of the first sites. Potable drinking water, vault toilets and garbage containers are provided. Each site has a table, fire ring and 2-horse corral. There is no camp host on site, but one travels through the camp daily. The camp is open all year, but used heavily in summer and fall.

Fees

Sites are \$20 per night. Ten of the sites are on the reservation system and can be made 240 days prior to your arrival by contacting ReserveUSA at 1-877-444-6777.

Description

This camp is located right on the edge of the dunes and about ½ mile from the ocean. It is surrounded by Shorepine, Douglas Fir and huckleberries. A trail from camp takes you directly to the beach where you can ride for several miles. Note – this is on the coast, so be prepared for harsh weather at any time.
