

# WHITEFISH HORSE CAMP

Crescent, OR

## Directions

From Medford go north on Hwy 62 to Hwy 230 and then east on Hwy 138 to Hwy 97. Go north on Hwy 97. Take the Hwy 58 exit towards Eugene/Oakridge. The little town of Crescent Lake is about 15 miles from the exit. In the middle of town turn left on Road 60, cross the railroad tracks, curve left and then make a sharp right turn. The camp is on the right in about 5 miles. The road is paved right to the campground. It takes about 3 hours to get there from Medford.

## Facilities

There are 17 sites in the camp. Most are 2-horse corrals, a few are 4-horse. Water spigots are plentiful in the camp. Manure is bagged and put in a trailer. Vault toilets are provided. Each site has a table, fire ring, horse stalls and parking spur. There is a camp host on site. The camp is open from late June to September depending on snow conditions.

## Fees

Sites are \$13 - \$15 per night depending on size. Reservations can be made 240 days prior to your arrival by contacting ReserveUSA at 1-877-444-6777.

## Description

This is a beautiful camp located on the Deschutes National Forest on Crescent Lake. Many trails make loops (3-6 hours long) and go past several beautiful lakes. Trails do get dusty in the late summer. It is recommended that you order a Crescent Ranger District map prior to arriving. Also check with the Forest Service about the trail conditions in early summer. This is a high area and the snow is slow to melt.
