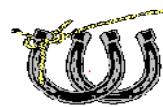

Directions: From Hwy 62 in White City, go east on Hwy 140 for about 28 miles. Turn left on Butte Falls /Willow Lake Rd. About 1 mile, turn left on FS Rd 3738. Go about 1 mile and turn left, go across cattle guard, go another 300 yards, turn left up the hill to the large day use area. (No need to pull through the horse camp on the right.)

Rules: Club rules apply. No stallions at the event, no dogs on the trail ride. Dogs must be leashed at all times for your dogs safety and to others or kept tied at camp. Riders 17 yrs of age and younger must wear an approved safety helmet while riding. Riders under 18 yrs of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult rider. Heeled boots required for all riders.

So any junior member (age 15-17) who is in good standing may apply to the board for the position. The board will then review the candidates and select one junior member, if none are acceptable the position may be left vacant.

Treasurer's Report- Bruce House reported the club had a beginning balance in the checking account of \$1,199.31; expenses \$1,676.00 income \$2,437.71 (after \$2,000.00 loan transfer to checking); ending balance in checking \$1,961.02; Joann Pool Fund \$3,550.70; cash on hand \$25.00; business ownership account \$20.41 for total cash assets of \$5,557.13. No outstanding club related bills to hand in. Motion was made, 2nd and approved to accept the treasurers report. Bruce explained about expenses such as the club insurance and balance owed on reserving Lily Glen Horse Park.

Sunshine Report- Carol Dombrowsky reported that she sent a card to Cori Carothers for an eye appointment. If anyone knows of a club member who could use an uplifting card, please contact Carol.

Ride JCHA Report– Karen House presented Dawn Cavanaugh with her 50 hours awards, a 50 hour bar patch and a cante bag.
