


Jackson County Horseman's Association Members Only Trail Horse Obstacle Clinic

This fun Trail Horse Obstacle Clinic will be held on **Saturday, March 26** at 4G's Arena at 109 Staley Rd, Eagle Point. Most of the obstacles are in the covered arena so this event will be rain or shine, UNLESS we are having a major storm!!

This clinic is open to members only. Non-members may join at the clinic. NO non-member guests will be allowed! The ranch owner is charging **\$15 per horse** so, please bring exact cash with you and be prepared to sign a hold harmless agreement.

There will be many different types of trail obstacles set up. You can take your horse through them at your own pace, either by in-hand or riding. There will be several horses in the arena at the same time doing different obstacles. Helpers will be on the ground to put the obstacles back in place.

We are going to have a potluck lunch around 12:00pm with BBQ hamburgers and table service provided by the club, so **please bring a salad or dessert to share**. Please bring your own non-alcoholic beverage and a chair.

If you're planning on riding in the Pear Blossom Parade in April, this is a good event to get your horse used to strange objects, people and other horses.

Dr. Beth Damon is again offering, discounted Coggins Test, Health Certificates or vaccines to those members needing them. Please contact Dr. Damon by texting her directly at (541) 621-0575. She needs to know how many and what to bring with her.

Please clean up around your horse trailer by picking up any horse manure, hay, shavings and trash before you leave!! If other members must clean up after you leave, you will not be allowed to participate next year!!

All participants, 17 years and under, will be required to wear a safety. Dogs must stay in vehicles or be on a short leash at all times.

Directions: *Go north on Hwy 62 past Eagle Point. In about 1/4 mile after the Butte Falls turnoff is Hammel Road on the left. Turn left, go up Hammel Road about 1/4 mile. 4G's Ranch driveway is on the left at the sharp curve, watch for signs. This is a very long narrow one-lane driveway, please watch for oncoming traffic.*
