Roll Call of Board was completed with President, Karen House, Vice President, Dawn DeVlaeminck, Treasurer, Bruce House, Secretary, Sabina Martin; absent, Sunshine, Carol Dombrowsky, Hospitality, Karen Matheny; absent, and Member at Large, David Browne, Junior Board Member, Clayre Shaffer.

Refreshments & Door Prize: Thanks went out to Stasea Martin and Dana Bartlett for refreshments, and to Karen House and Karen Matheny for the door prizes.

Introduction of New Members and Guests: New members are: Lori Fox, Joy and Adam Lowell. Welcomed guests were: Ernie Boggs, Mackenzie Ferguson and Brad Morton.

May Minutes: It was motioned and seconded that the May minutes be approved as written in the newsletter.

Treasurer's Report by Bruce House The beginning checking account balance is \$6,619.05, income of \$383.00, expenses of \$100.00, leaving a checking account balance of \$6,902.05. Joann Pool Fund is \$1,663.74, cash on hand of \$25.00, total assets of \$8,573.71. It was motioned and seconded that the Treasurer's Report be approved as presented. No club expenses were handed in.

Sunshine Report: Carol Dombrowsky sending out a get well card to Stasea & Sabina Martin's dad who is in the hospital.

Ride JCHA Committee Report & Discussion: After a brief narrative of the program to new members & guests, Karen House reported that Kay Johnson earned her 25 hour patch & ID Tag, Claire Baker earned her 100 hour patch & first aid kit. Karen awarded Judy Klein with her 50 hour patch & cantele bag, Laura Woolley, Phyllis Pfaff, Penney Reed & Peggy Pitt with their 250 hour patch and trail bells.

Junior News: Clayre Shaffer reported that there are several upcoming events: The Rowdy Bunch Gymkhana on June 25 at Salt Creek Arena, Redwood Coast Gymkhana on July 16, Grayback Gymkhana in July, St. Jude ride June 17, JCHA Lily Glen Campout & Events June 30-July 2, a friend of Clayre is having a Fundraiser Barrel Race July 1, and Salt Creek Arena is wanting to put on more trail trials, gymkhanas and more.

Field Representative: Cyndi Rach reported she had talked with Alexandria Weinbrecht of the Applegate Trails Association saying that the Applegate Ridge Trail is coming along and almost finished. They are making some wide spots for horses to travel on.

JCHA Event Planning:

St. Jude Benefit Ride - June 17: Everything is a go at Willow Prairie. Leann Quint and other riders will flag the trail for the ride. First riders out at 10:00am till 11:00am with the drag rider pulling flagging. The "Tacofest Potluck" is at 5pm in campsite #3, please bring something to share. All the campsites are all full but you are welcome to dry camp on any of the cinder roads. The camp host site is open with corrals.

Lily Glen Horse Events Weekend - June 30-July 1&2: Only a couple of weeks away! The club has the A & B Group Areas reserved Friday and Saturday nights, those camping sites/corrals are on a first come first serve basis. Dry camping is available in the mowed meadow area where horses can be high lined or bring your own portable corrals. You can also camp in the camp sites to the left of the entry road but you will pay the county park fee. Candy Harvey has 9 confirmed judges to judge the trail trial. She is plotting the trail route, the creek is a concern because of all the rain. There was a long discussion on riding across the creek and having an alternate route across or even mark a trail across the Hwy like we had 3 years ago. If you want to camp longer than the weekend, you will need to pay the county park fees. Club furnishing meat/buns for potluck. Also, all club members attending please wear a club t-shirt so anyone with questions can find a club member for help.

Lake Selmac Campout— Candy Harvey reported that the trail around the lake has many large tree downfalls making the trails difficult to ride, Search and Rescue has been working the trails. It was discussed at the April meeting to have a volunteer work/cleanup day at the camp in exchange for camping, but this years rainfall and blowdowns are more than were expected and it looked to be more than one days worth of work. It was motioned and 2nd to cancel the work day and camping for this year and reconsider it for next year.

Old Business:

Willow Prairie Work Day Recap: Cyndi Rach reported that it was a good turnout, with members bringing 4 wheelers & horses to use to clear trails while some members hiked. The worst trails were Rye Meadow trails, it has been approximately 5 years since we've been able to work and clear those trails. If anyone has a location of specific downfall on designated trails that needs to be cleared, they can report it to Scott Beemer at Butte Falls Ranger Dist. This year the members logged 99.5 hours of volunteer clean up work for the 4-5 hours work out on the trails. Thanks everyone!

Memorial Day Campout - Recap: Weather was cool but nice. Orman's Ranch as always, was accommodating with their roomy paddocks for the horses and secluded campsites. Some new members attending for the their first time suggested that next year to have hand out information on where to find and ride the trails/beaches and do a meet and greet with other JCHA members camping there. Also, if you have a horse that has a vice please mark their tail with a colored ribbon.

Other Old Business:

Chairmen for Fall Events:

Still in need of chairmen for fall events, The Ta-Ta Benefit Horse Show Oct 22: not sure if it's too late to schedule as we need a venue, judges, prizes. If no one chairs this event will be canceled. The End of Summer Poker/Lingo Ride Sept 23 at Willow Prairie: Judy Klein offered to chair this event with help from Dana Bartlett. They need volunteers for dealers out on the trail. Debbie Davenport reported that campsites are vacant for that date, go to Recreation.Gov for camp site availability.

New Business:

Guest Speaker: Joy Lowell of the Rogue Riders Endurance Group spoke about her groups upcoming 40, 50 endurance rides and a 10 mile trail ride, the Pacific Crest Endurance Ride up at Lily Glen Horse Park on July 22nd. If your not into endurance riding, the fun 10 mile trail ride is for you! Great for young riders, awards being donated by The Horse Blanket. The trails will be well marked with different colored flagging. They could also use some volunteer help during the rides. 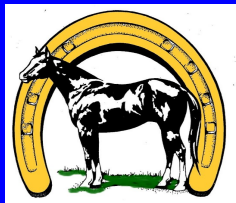
