Board Meeting

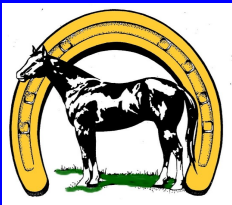
There will be a board meeting on Wednesday, May 4th at 6:00pm at Wild River Pizza in Medford. All members are welcome to attend board meetings.

Treasurer's Report : March expenses, \$1,740.82, income \$1,147.50. Checking account balance \$6,619.08, Joann Pool Fund, \$1,652.32 and \$50 cash for total of \$8,321.40. Report was approved.

Sunshine Report: Carol Dombrowsky said she sent a card to Karen House for her surgery. Need to send one to Leann Tucker for her surgery.

RideJCHA Report: None this month. Question was asked why we didn't have more milestones such as 750 and more between 2000 and 5000. Debbie Davenport said it mostly was because of the cost to purchase the milestone bar patches. They are expensive because we have to purchase quite a few of each one. If someone could come up with a less expensive patch that could be considered.

JCHA Events:
