This fun Trail Horse Obstacle Clinic will be held on **Saturday, March 16th** at 4G's Arena at 109 Staley Rd, Eagle Point. Most of the obstacles are in the covered arena so this event will be rain or shine.

This clinic is open to JCHA members only, non-members may join at the clinic. NO non-member guests will be allowed! Signups are at 9:00am and the ranch owner is charging **\$10 per horse** so, please bring exact cash with you and be prepared to sign a hold harmless agreement.

There will be many different types of trail obstacles set up. You can take your horse through them at your own pace, either by in-hand or riding. There will be several horses in the arena at the same time doing different obstacles. Helpers will be on the ground to put the obstacles back in place.

We are going to have a potluck lunch around 12:00pm with BBQ hamburgers and table service is provided by the club, so **please bring a salad or dessert to share**. Please bring your own non-alcoholic beverage and a chair.

If you're planning on riding in the Pear Blossom Parade in April, this is a good event to get your horse used to strange objects, people and other horses.

Directions: *Go north on Hwy 62 past Eagle Point. In about 1/4 mile after the Butte Falls turnoff is Hammel Road on the left. Turn left and go up Hammel Road about 1/4 mile. 4G's Ranch driveway is on the left at the sharp curve, watch for signs and balloons. The driveway is very long and narrow with some turnouts; please watch for oncoming traffic, there will be designated trailer parking areas to park in.*
