November Minutes – Motion was made and approved to accept the minutes as printed in newsletter.

Treasurer Report – Bruce House gave the report – Beginning balance in checking account- \$6,004.66; expenses \$1,324.50; income \$916.97. Ending balance in checking \$5597.13; Joann Pool fund \$4,368.73; cash \$25.00 for total assets of \$9,990.86. Motion was made and approved to accept treasurer report.

Sunshine Report – Carol Dombrowsky said she sent a card to the Moore family.

RIDEJCHA Report – Karen House said no awards this month.

Junior Member Report - None - Kali absent

Old Business -

Christmas Party – Great success, well attended with about 70 members and guests. Penney Reed did a wonderful job setting it up and working with the Eagles.

Calendar of Events draft was discussed. Added a date for the Lingo Ride. Discussed Carol Mercer would do a Liberty Training (no horses) if the club would be interested, and Welcome Ranch is willing to do something with the club. No dates yet. Motion was made and approved to accept the rest of the calendar as drafted.

New Business -

The Board of Directors brought up the discussion that the club dues had not been increased in over 24 years. Even dues for other groups have gone up in the last few years. The board suggested we raise the dues from \$15 for single to \$20; Family from \$30 to \$40; Junior from \$10 to \$15 beginning with 2023. Motion was made and approved to increase the dues as noted.

Discussed doing an apparel order in February.

The board presented the budget for 2023. Motion was made and approved to accept. Budget will be posted in the newsletter and on the members only section of the website.

Nominations for the 2023 Board of Directors was open. Sabina Martin was nominated for President; Karen House for Vice President; Bruce House for Treasurer; Debbie Davenport for Secretary but she declined the nomination; Carol Dombrowsky for Sunshine; Sandi Humphfres for Hospitality; no one was nominated for Member At Large. Motion was made and approved to table the nominations until the January meeting when they will be opened again prior to voting.

We received a thank you from Access for the donation of the canned goods from the Christmas Party. The toys were donated to the Josephine Co Sheriff Dept for distribution.

Sabina asked if anyone had any changes to the Bylaws to propose so they could be voted on at the January meeting. No one responded.

Reminder that the Annual Meeting of the Membership is January 11, 2023. We will vote for Board of Directors along with other club business. We will also do the annual chili and cornbread cookoff. Chili winner will get \$50, cornbread \$25. Club will furnish the door prize.

Door Prize Drawings – Group agreed to not do a drawing tonight.
