JCHA Monthly Meeting Minutes - Sept 10, 2019 Submitted by Michelle Morton for Debbie Davenport

President Karen House call the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Thanks to Amanda Anderson, Sandi Humphries & Karen House for refreshments; Debbie Davenport, and Karen House for door prizes.

Roll Call of the Board - The board members were present except for Debbie Davenport and Karen Matheny who were both absent.

Guest & New Members- Guests present were Dian Weiberg she has a breeding stock Paint mare and a Quarter Horse, Clayre Shaffer has 3 horses, Joe Hamrick (guest of Laurie Fox) rides a Mustang. Pam & Philip Keuter have Morgans and were welcomed to their 1st meeting.

July Minutes - Karen asked if everyone had read the minutes and if there were any questions. Motion was made and approved to accept the minutes as printed in the newsletter.

Treasurers Report - Bruce stated the two-month income was \$2,986.00, expenses were \$1,640.33, leaving a checking balance of \$8,748.62, cash on hand \$25, Joann Poole Fund \$1,986.04 for a total balance of \$10,759.66. Motion was made and approved to accept the report as read. There were no club bills presented.

Sunshine Report - Carol said she sent cards to Amy Segovia, Lorraine Rawls, Debbie Davenport and Karen Matheny.

Ride JCHA Report- Karen House explained the program and then presented awards to Kimberly Hertel for her 25 & 50 hour awards, Terri Campfield her for 1,000 hours, and Karen House for 1,500 hours. Total hours are about 12,850.

Field Services Report – Judy Klein reported that at the last Multi Users Meeting they are to facilitate their own meetings. The equestrian group said that Trail Triangle signs need to be on all trails for users to know who yields to who, also safety/education for horse and bike riders. National Public Lands Day is Sept 28, Multi Trail Users with BLM/USFS to have a trail day at the Claude Lewis Trail Head with a meet/greet and workday.

JCHA Event Planning:

Ta Ta Trot Benefit Show - Stasea Martin announced that the show judge is Jami Kaptein and trail judge is Carla Resh. There are classes for all ages. Many high point and class sponsorships have been received so far from individuals and businesses. Crescent City Campout – Sabina Martin reported many members attended and enjoyed the campout and rides in the Redwoods and at the beach. NWTR had their trail trial, poker/lingo rides, but attendance was low for their fundraiser. Sisters already have the group area reserved for next year!

Gymkhana- Well attended with 48 horses. Much thanks to Amanda Anderson and her volunteer crew for a great event!

Memorial Plaque for Gail Bradley- Carol Dombrowsky called for a quote to have a memorial plaque made in memory of Gail Bradley. A motion was made and 2nd to order one at the cost of \$125.00.

It will be placed on the handicap mounting block at Lily Glen. Scott Bradley will furnish a photo and wording for the plaque. Also discussed was an additional memorial plaque for more names of fallen JCHA members.

Junior Member Credit Program- Judy Klein explained the program and how it will benefit the junior members in attending club events, paying for memberships, etc. with earned credits for helping in club events. The committee will meet again before a future club meeting.

New Business:

Gymkhana Bases/Poles- The club now has their own PVC poles/bases for club gymkhanas, total cost was \$119.00.
