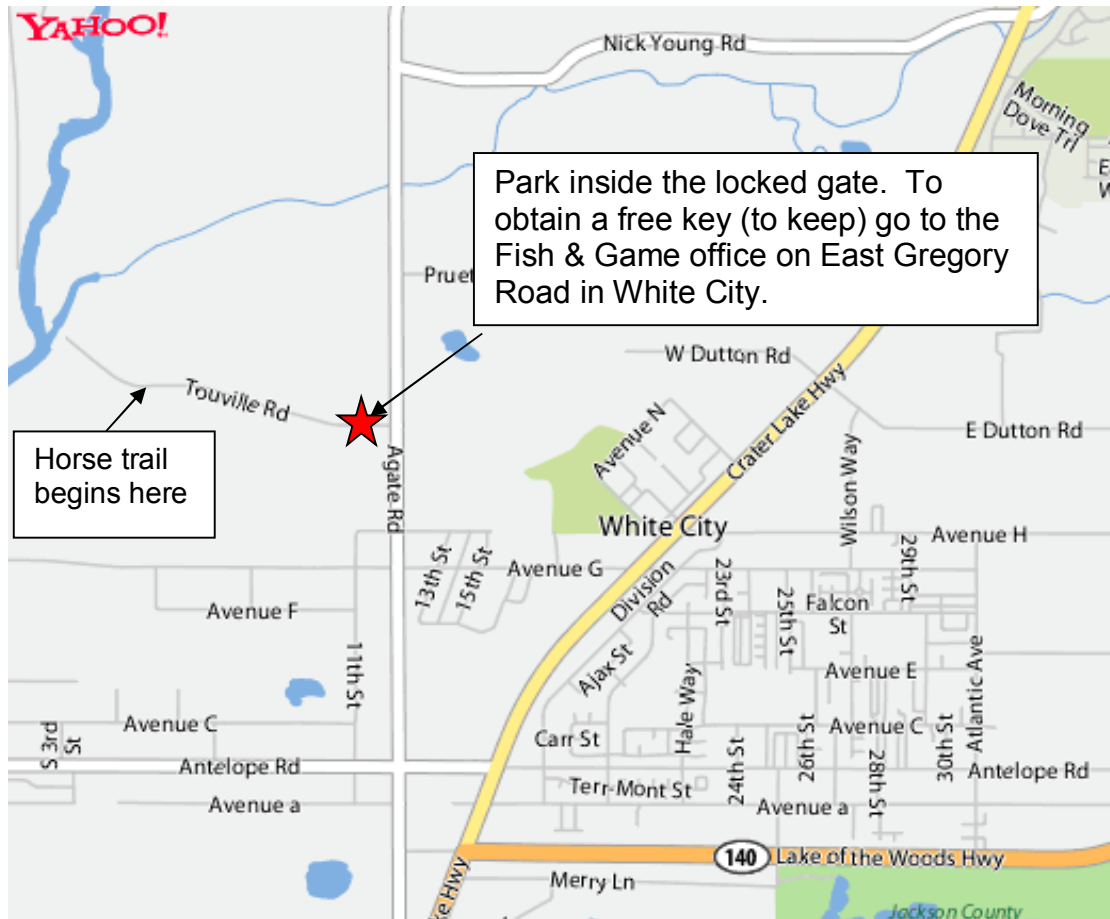


Denman Wildlife Area – Agate Road



Denman Wildlife area offers a wonderful riding opportunity for equestrians that don't want to travel far, but still be in a woody setting. The Fish & Game have developed some trails especially for horses, but you can actually follow any trail you wish unless it is marked "no horses".

It is difficult to get lost out here because you have roads intersecting that all lead back to Agate Road, fences and the creek as borders. If you try to cross the creek, use caution as there are deep pockets that are not always visible.

You can make a nice one hour loop, or wander around for a longer ride. You may encounter bicycles on the roads, hikers with dogs on a leash, etc. All good practice for a trail horse!!

Depending on the time of the year, ticks and/or mosquitoes can be bothersome.

PLEASE pick up after yourself and your horse (at your trailer). We want to show that equestrians can practice 'leave no trace' better than other trail users!!

Beginning Jan. 1, 2012, a parking permit will be required at Denman Wildlife Area. Permits can be purchased at [ODFW License vendors](#), at [ODFW offices that sell licenses](#) and [online at ODFW's website](#). Cost is \$7 per day or \$22 for the annual permit.
