Introduction of New Members and Guests- None present.

No outstanding club related bills to hand in. Motion was made, 2nd and approved to accept the treasurer's report.

Sunshine Report- Carol Dombrowsky sent cards to: Jill Miakovsky for the loss of her husband, Peggy Pitt for falling off a young horse on a trail ride, Sabina Martin for extensive injuries due to an unplanned buck off and to Fred West for open heart surgery. Ride JCHA Report- Karen House announced awards to Lori Johnson for reaching her 1,000 hours, she receives an embroidered hay bag and a 1,000 hour bar patch. Then to Terri Campfield for reaching her 5,000 hours. Karen presented her with a 5,000 hour silver western buckle from Molly Silver Buckles and a 5,000 hour bar patch. It took Terri 10.5 yrs to reach 5,000 hours! Because Terri wanted to continue logging her hours in the program, it was decided to continue the hour levels with the next award at 6,000 hours with a hour bar patch only, any future hour levels will have bar patches awarded only.
