"Members Only" Trail Horse Obstacle Clinic

10:00am-4:00pm



This fun Trail Horse Obstacle Clinic will be held on **Saturday, March 28** at 4G's Ranch, 109 Staley Rd, Eagle Point. There will be obstacles in the covered arena and outside, so this event will be rain or shine.

This clinic is open to JCHA members only; if you have friends who are non-members and they want to ride the obstacles, they may join the club at the clinic. NO non-member guests will be allowed! The ranch owner is charging **\$10 per horse** so please bring exact cash with you and be prepared to sign a hold harmless agreement.

There will be many different types of trail obstacles set up. You can take your horse through them at your own pace, either by in-hand or riding. There will be several horses in the arena and outside at the same time doing different obstacles. Helpers will be on the ground to put the obstacles back in place and to help if you need assistance.

A potluck lunch is scheduled around noon; **bring a main dish, salad, chips or a dessert to share, table service provided by the club. Also bring your own non-alcoholic beverage and a chair.**

*Note this is a private ranch and residence so.....

*Leave it like you found it by cleaning up around your horse trailer for any horse manure, hay, shavings and trash before you leave!!

*All participants 17 years and under will be required to wear an approved safety helmet, heeled boots are suggested, please leave dogs and stallions at home...

Directions: Go north on Hwy 62 past Eagle Point. In about 1/4 mile after the Butte Falls turnoff is Hammel Road on the left. Turn left; go up Hammel Road about 1/4 mile. 4G's Ranch driveway is on the left at the sharp curve, watch for signs and balloons. This is a long narrow one-lane gravel driveway, so watch for oncoming traffic and designated trailer parking areas to park in.
