Introduction of New Members and Guests: We had one guest, Denise Willis.

May Minutes: Motion passed that the May minutes be approved as written in the newsletter.

Treasurer's Report by Glenna Van Buskirk. The beginning checking account balance is \$4,582.39, income of \$2,824.00, expenses of \$790.57, for a balance of \$6,615.82. Cash on hand \$25, Joann Pool Fund \$1,340.18, with a new balance and total assets of \$7,993.72.

Sunshine Report: Carol Dombrowsky reported that she sent cards to Sophia Brydon and Claire Baker. Carol will send out cards to Sabina Martin who injured her ribs and to Jeannie King who hasn't been feeling well.

Ride JCHA Committee Report & Discussion: Karen House reported to the members that there were a total of 6,475 group riding hours. Candy Harvey received her 25 and 50 hour awards and Claire Baker received a 25 hour award. Trail riding materials are available on the club website. Ride JCHA is a program to record your hours in the saddle for awards. There is a one-time charge of \$15 to join for adults. To participate in Ride JCHA, you need to keep your club membership current.

JCHA Event Planning:

St. Jude's Benefit Ride - June 18: Karen Matheny and Linda Carlson are hosting the event this year. Karen reported that the trail will be covered with long pink ribbons so no one will get lost. One blow down was cleared but we are still cleaning the trail and will be up at Willow Prairie starting this Saturday, June 11th.

Karen and Linda are camping in Sites 2 & 3 where the check in for the St Jude ride will be located. They ask you bring your donations, sign up and start the ride from there. First rider out at 10 am, with last riders out at 11:00. Please ride the trail around the outside of camp when you come to sign up or walk down from the overflow. Potluck will begin close to 4 p.m. with the club furnishing hamburgers, buns and condiments. Please bring a dish to share, a chair, and something to drink. Some club members will be happy to share available open corrals so that you don't need to leave your tired horses tied to horse trailers. Be sure to clean up any manure before you leave!!

Quinn Meadows - July 29 - 31st: Hosted by Colleen Martin-Lowe. Camp is full with at least 11 to 14 members coming. Motion was made and approved for \$40 to pay for pork for the potluck on Saturday. Family Fun Spring Schooling - May 22: Stasea Martin reported they had 64 horses and 67 riders with an income of \$2,670.

After expenses and paying the Expo a \$5.00 per horse haul in fee, it left a profit of \$1,000.95. High point's awards were handed out and will be posted soon to the newsletter, our Facebook page and club website.

Memorial Day Camp Out - May 28 - 31st: Stasea Martin and Sabina reported that they had a successful campout and ride. They only had 3 - 5 club members attend but they rode every trail they could find. They all also enjoyed the night ride and chili feed hosted by the Northwest Trail Riders.

Lily Glen Trail Trial Judges Meeting: Candy Harvey reported that they had a meeting on May 23 at Abbys. She had 7 judges show up and she has more than enough judges to cover a full list of obstacles. The judges will ride this Saturday at Lily Glen at 10:30am to map out a 2 hour ride. If any of the judges coming has a GPS that would be helpful to map the trails.

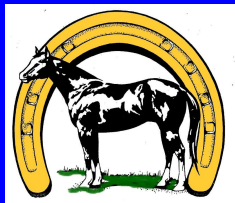
JCHA Website Reminder: The password for the "members only" page is 2016member. Enter it together and in lowercase.
