May meeting minutes were printed and handed out at the door, as well as Jami B read aloud. One correction was made to the sunshine report: Dawn C's dog was having a surgery/procedure done, not her daughter. Motion to accept the minutes by Dawn, Second by David approved.

Treasurer's report: Checking account \$3,121.79 Savings account (Joann Pool Fund) \$4,689.79 Ownership account \$29.56 Cash on hand \$25.00 Total=\$7,866.14 Motion to approve was passed.

Sunshine report: Suggested card to Debi Smith due to loss of a horse.

Youth sponsorship: as discussed in the May's meeting, Eliana and Heaven both received a \$500 sponsorship.

Ride JCHA- Karen not present at the meeting to report any updates

Jr Member- Eliana not present at the meeting to report any updates

JCHA Event Planning- June trail ride (Terri Campfield): Trail has been cleared and is ready for the weekend. Signs have been made (thank you Debbie) for road crossing areas. It is asked to please stay in a group while crossing the road.

July 3-5 Lilly Glen Camp out: Glen and Jodi Stacy donated \$20 for the ride and Lora donated an electric grill for the auction. Sandi, Mackenzie and Sabina will be there on the 3rd to get the trail marked out and cleared further. Everything is in order to proceed.

Old business: Knife River donated and delivered the rock to Willow Prairie. Debbie stated that after multiple failed attempts with the previous group who did the rock delivery in years prior, she was able to have Knife River deliver the donated rock. In the meeting previously the estimated price was up to \$150 for delivery with the previous company, however at the time of delivery and the change to using Knife River, the total came to \$400. She requested/suggested that the club reimburse her the \$150 as previously discussed, and she donated the remaining amount. Motion was made and approved. This was handled by Treasurer Jami.

New business: Endurance ride gift certificates- Due to Facebook flagging and removing the posts to sell the raffle tickets for the ride, Jami has been unable to successfully get the post out and tickets sold. It was discussed to bring the tickets to the June trail ride and donate them to two people who are interested in the ride. If there are no takers at this ride, then an email is to be sent out to all JCHA members to submit their names into a random name drawing to win the certificate. A date limit will be provided at the time of the email to have the names in by, and the random draw will be done on that date for the two winners. Discussion concluded to donate the certificate instead of trying to sell tickets to make money from them. Motion by Debbie and second by Dawn. Motion approved.

Other new information: Dawn C stated that a "verbal written agreement" for 5 years had been talked about with the Forest Service for Willow Prairie. This would be signed by Dawn and Back Country Horseman. Dawn suggesting this is signed as JCHA to also have a partnership with Back Country in this agreement. It entails clean up, management of the park and more. Documents requested to be brought to the board prior to signing anything in the name of JCHA to be further discussed.

Warnings for trail riders: Prospect had a recent cougar attack on a horse. Orick trail camp does have a bear that frequents the trails. Please use caution.

Door prize winners: Dawn, Diane, Terri, Sharon and Jill. Each member who bought a ticket had a chance to get one prize. As discussed, any remaining door prizes are to go to the Lilly Glen camp out raffle.

Buckaroo drawing was won previously and donated back at the last meeting, bringing the drawing back to \$20. Name drawn was to Deb Younker who was not present at the meeting to win.

Camping:

We have reserved Group Camp Area B for Friday and Saturday nights, July 3 and 4th. There are several camping spaces (which will be shared). Overflow campers will be placed in the adjacent meadow. No reserves on specific campsites or corrals; first come – first choice. Corrals go fast, so plan to bring portable corrals or highline. The camp has vault toilets and a fresh water hand pump. Cost for camping is \$18 per night per family (i.e. - one truck/trailer combination). If you camp in the no reservation area to the left of the entrance you must pay the County Park camp fee of \$28/night (includes 1 vehicle) with maximum of 8 people per camp site. Please practice “Leave NO Trace” in camp areas, stalls and on trails. Come prepared to clean up after your horses (No one wants your left over manure or hay)! NOTE: Certified Weed Free Hay is NOT required at this camp.

Potluck:

Saturday afternoon at 12:30pm we will have a potluck at the sign up area. Please bring a **main dish** to share with the group. Bring a chair and beverages of your choice, no alcohol.

Raffle and Silent Auction:

You may purchase raffle tickets for \$5 for 10 tickets or \$2.00 a piece. Place them in the bucket of the prize you wish to win. Silent Auction items will be available all day for bidding. Drawing of raffle and winners of silent auction will be announced starting at 1pm

Lingo & Poker Ride:

Saturday July 4th Both of these events are on the same trail (You can participate in one or both events.) Lingo (aka Bingo) numbers are posted along the trail. Participants mark off the numbers on their cards. A blackout wins the money pot. If no blackout occurs, the card with the fewest numbers left wins. Ties will split the pot. Cards are \$5 each or 3 cards for \$12. One half of the money collected goes to the winner(s). The Poker Ride will run the same way. You will draw a 5-card hand. Highest hand and lowest hand will split the money. One hand is \$5 or 3 hands for \$12. Winners will be announced Saturday after silent auction / raffle is concluded or as soon as they are ready.

Rules:

- 1) No stallions allowed at the campout or in the events.
- 2) No dogs allowed on the event rides and per Jackson County Parks Rules- If you bring dogs to the campout they must be kept tied up in your camp or on a leash at all times for your dogs safety and for safety to others.
- 3) All children 17 years of age and younger are required to wear a safety helmet while riding in any event.
- 4) Heeled boots required for all riders for all events.
- 5) Riders under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult rider.
- 6) All club rules apply at this event along with the Inherent Risk Law of Oregon, ORS 30.689.
- 7) No alcohol during the ride.

We are offering a discount for pre-registration. Fill out the form attached to this flyer, add up the total amount and subtract 10% if you are a non-club member or 20% if you belong to JCHA. Directions to Lily Glen:

The shortest route is to take I-5 south to Ashland exit 14. Head east on Dead Indian Memorial Hwy for about 17 miles, climbing up the steep, winding mountain then dropping down toward Howard Prairie Reservoir. Go past the turnoff to Howard Prairie Resort approx. 1/2 mile and watch for the camp on the right.

For an easier haul, but a few extra miles, take Hwy 140 from White City east towards Klamath Falls for 28 miles then turn onto FS Rd 37 - North Fork Campground Road. Follow it to the end (9 miles) and turn right on Dead Indian Memorial Hwy. Lily Glen is about 4 miles on the left.
