****Buckle classes 11 and 22 are open to all competitors any level except Novice/Greenhorn. If only entering the Buckle classes: 11 Open Level 3 In-Hand & 22 Open Level 3 Ride, participants shall pay \$30 Buckle class entry fee per class.**

Circle Classes Entering

Mini Equine: Horse 11 hands and under.

Youth: Ages 12 and under as of January 1, 2023

Novice: First year the handler/rider is competing trail obstacles in any organized trail or cowboy race competitions.

Greenhorn: Any handler/rider who has not won 3 or more First place ribbons in any organized trail, mountain trail or cowboy race competitions.

Jr. Horse: Equine age 3 and under as of January 1, 2023.

Open: All riders qualified except for Novice.

Trainers: Any rider who is paid to train or give lessons, can ONLY go in Open classes.

Lead Line: Rider on horse; horse on-line; person on ground; Age 8 and under.

Novice: Walking over obstacles/lesser degree of difficulty than Level 1.

Greenhorn: Beginning training, walk only, in hand or riding.

Level 1: Training, walk only, in hand or riding.

Level 2: Intermediate, walk and trot, in hand & riding. 180 & 360 degrees on some obstacles.

Level 3: Master, walk, trot and canter, 180 & 360 degrees on some obstacles.

2023 JCHA Trail Challenge

Participation Rules

1. Scores will be tabulated for each horse/rider combination for placings.
2. Open Classes are open to Trainers and all other participants, excluding Novice. Trainers can only participate in open classes.
3. If we have **3 or more** Youth or minis participate, Youth and or/Mini will be separated into a Youth and/or mini class for all levels except Open.
4. Each Horse/Rider combination can participate in only 2 levels.
Novice/Greenhorn. Greenhorn/Level 1, Level 1/Level2, Level 2/Level 3.
5. Ribbons for placings First through Fifth will be awarded to all classes.
6. High Point will be awarded to high score of combined participation in the following divisions:
 - Novice/Greenhorn In-Hand & Ride Classes 1, 2, 13, 14
 - Greenhorn/Level 1 In-Hand & Ride Classes 2, 3, 14, 15
 - Level 1/Level 2 In-Hand & Ride Classes 3, 4, 15,16
 - Level 2/Level 3 In-Hand & Ride Classes 4, 5, 16, 17
 - Open Jr Horse In-Hand & Ride Classes 8, 10, 19, 21 (3 or more entries required)
 - Overall Mini (if applicable, see rule 3 above)
 - Overall Youth (if applicable, see rule 3 above)
 - Open In-Hand Classes 7, 9 (Level 1 & Level 2) -or- 9, 11 (Level 2 & Level 3)
 - Open Ride Classes 18, 20 (Level 1 & Level 2) – or -20, 22 (Level 2 & Level 3)
 - Buckle classes 11, 22 (Level 3 only)
