## **JCHA Monthly Meeting Minutes - June 12, 2019 Submitted by Debbie Davenport, Secretary**

President Karen House call the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Thanks to Judy Klein for bringing refreshments tonight. No door prize available.

**Roll Call of the Board** –All members present, except Karen Matheny who was absent.

**New Members** – No new members or guests present.

**May Minutes** - Debbie asked if everyone had read the minutes and if there were any questions. Motion was made and approved to accept the minutes as printed.

**Treasurers Report** - Bruce stated the monthly income was \$1318.00, expenses were \$1393.92, leaving a checking balance of \$5757.71, cash on hand \$25, Joann Poole Fund \$2050.79 for a total balance of \$7833.50. Motion was made and approved to accept the report as read. No other club bills were presented.

**Sunshine Report** - Carol sent a thank you card to Judy Taylor for cost of corral poles donated by OET.

**Ride JCHA Report**- Award this month went to Lori Johnson for reaching 250 & 500 Hours. RideJCHA hours to date are 11,550 hours.

**Junior Member Report** – Jordawn reported that OHSET regionals are in Redmond, OR this weekend with one team member from Crater going.

**Field Services Report** – Judy Klein said the last meeting of the Multi-user group had a panel of representatives with about 30 people there to help the Multi-user group plan, discuss grants, etc. The Oregon Trails Summit scheduled for October is being held in Roseburg and Judy will attend.

### **JCHA Event Planning:**

**St Jude Ride** - June 15<sup>th</sup> at Willow Prairie Horse Camp. Ride is all set. There will be a no host potluck around 4:00ish in campsite #3, bring a dish to share, chair & drink. There is one campsite available, contact Debbie Davenport.

Friday will be the gymkhana and Saturday will be the Lingo/Poker Ride, rebus puzzles on the same trail, later that evening the BBQ potluck, awards, silent auctions and raffle winners announced. **Willow Prairie Work Party Recap**- Four members and the campground hosts worked on corrals in camp while others walked and rode 4-wheelers to clear trails. At total of 61.5 volunteer hours for the day.

**Gymkhana Recap**- Attendance was light with 28 horses. Everyone had a good time, big thank you to all members who helped. With expense of arenas, extra insurance and low attendance we lost \$204.55.

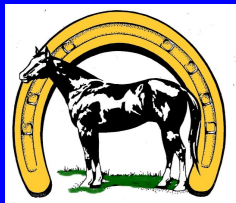
**Junior Member Credit Program** – Michelle Morton explained the Junior Credit Program that will be open to all JCHA youth ages 18 and under who want assistance to participate in club events. They can earn credits to use towards paying for annual membership or events by helping at JCHA events, attending meetings, help mentor other current junior and new junior members, co-chair events, report on horse seminars or clinics. This pilot program is separate from the Youth Sponsorship Program which requires youth to be enrolled in an equestrian activity such as FFA, OHSET and 4-H.

**President and Treasurer Board Positions**- Karen and Bruce House announced that they won’t seek re-election on the 2020 Board. Members are encouraged to run for these open positions in December. They must be a member in good standing and have attended 4 membership meetings during the year. They also asked that more members take on chairing and organizing club events.
