Reservations for Willow Prairie Horse Camp can be made on [www.recreation.gov](http://www.recreation.gov)

Directions: From Hwy 62 in White City, go east on Hwy 140 for about 28 miles. Turn left on Butte Falls/Willow Lake Rd. About 1 mile, turn left on F5 Rd 3738. Go about 1 mile and turn left, go across cattle guard, go another 300 yards, turn left up the hill to the large day use area. (No need to pull through the horse camp on the right.)

Rules: No stallions at the event, no dogs on the trail ride. Dogs must be leashed at all times for your dogs safety and to others or kept tied at camp. Riders 17 yrs of age and younger must wear an approved safety helmet while riding. Riders under 18 yrs of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult rider. Heeled boots required for all riders. ORS 30.691 - Equine Inherent Risk Law of Oregon applies to all activities of this organization.
