2020 JCHA Board of Directors Positions

Nominations will be taken at the December meeting for the 2020 Board of Directors. **ALL** positions are voted for each year. **"The President, Vice-President and Treasurer are stepping down for 2020 so we definitely need members to run for these positions!! No executive board – no club!"** PLEASE consider running for a position on the board!! Here is a brief explanation of the offices:

President—Presides at all board meetings and meetings of the membership. He/she shall have general supervision over the other officers and shall act as general manager of the affairs of the Corporation.

Vice President—Take over duties of the President when necessary.

Secretary—Take minutes, does correspondence, maintains a current membership roster.

Treasurer—Maintain records of all club funds.

Sunshine – Sends out greeting cards to members when deemed necessary.

Hospitality – Be at scheduled meetings to open the building, start the refreshments and be responsible for closing up after the meetings.

At Large – Be available to perform any duties of the Board when requested.

Directors must be 18 years or older and have been a voting member in good standing for a minimum of one year prior to election. In addition, to be eligible for an Officer position (top 4 listed), the member must have attended a minimum of four regular monthly meetings in the year prior to election. No member may hold more than one position concurrently.

Youth Sponsorship Program

This program runs from January 1st to April 1st. The information and application will be available on the JCHA website December 1st. The annual fund is \$1,500.

Please spread the word to youth, applicants must be between 13-18 years of age (as of January 1) and be enrolled in an equine activity in Southern Oregon, and that they are welcome to join JCHA and apply for the sponsorship.

Roll Call of the Board –All members present.

Guests – Lisa Nelson moved here from Texas recently; Alexandria & Richard French, have one horse – looking for another; and Missy Harrison new member who joined at the horse show.

October Minutes - Debbie asked if everyone had read the minutes and if there were any questions. Motion was made and approved to accept the minutes as printed.

Treasurers Report - Bruce stated the monthly income was \$5189.50, expenses were \$1284.50, leaving a checking balance of \$13417.31, cash on hand \$25, Joann Poole Fund \$1990.28 for a total balance of \$15,432.59. Motion was made and approved to accept the report as read. No other club bills were presented.

Sunshine Report - Carol said cards were sent to: Sandi Humphres for her dog passing, Sabina Martin for broken ribs, Dana Bartlett for her illness, Linda Carlson for illness, Amanda Anderson & Indie, and Colleen Martin-Low for loss of dog.

Ride JCHA Report- Two members received awards- Chloe Evans for her 50, 100 and 250 hours; and Juliana Evans for her 100 hours in the saddle.

Field Services Report – Judy Klein said she has been attending the monthly multi use trail group meetings. In June the Rogue Riders are putting DG in the stalls at Lily Glen. The group is looking at several items the BLM is proposing, there will be another work party at Sam Brown horse camp in the spring, snowmobile group working on the Fish Lake trail, Dollar Mtn acres are being developed for hikers, bikers and equestrians. USFS gave the group \$30,000 to work on projects, to be used by 5/1/20. They are hiring a facilitator from Bend to help organize and plan the projects and determine the best way to use the money.

Jr Member Credit Program – Michelle Morton outlined the program. This program started effective 10/1/2019. Details are on the website.

JCHA Event Planning:

Christmas Party – Party is on Friday, Dec 6th this year. Flyer and reservation form are available tonight and on the website. Must pay and reserve by November 30th.

Old Business:

Ta-Ta Trot Show – It was a huge show. 95 horses participated. It went very well, long though. Not all the expenses are in yet, but currently it looks like the profit will be about \$3,600. The chairmen are working on getting the High Point awards ordered. Once all the bills are accounted for, we will determine how to split the profits for donations to breast cancer funds. It was also noted that between the rental of the fairgrounds and the payment for \$5 per horse haul in fee we paid them \$1050 for the one-day event. Also, the PA system quit working shortly after the event began.

Memorial Plaque – Plaque for Gail Bradley was on display at the meeting. Mark W. will make a wooden frame to match the one on Dave Doran's plaque. Both plaques will be hung at Lily Glen in the spring. Suggested we have a ride or potluck when they are hung again.

New Business:

2020 Calendar of events was drafted. It will be posted in the newsletter. It will be voted on at the December meeting. Karen listed the year-end reminders of nominations for board members will be done at the December meeting, Board of Directors will present the 2020 budget at the Dec meeting, and any changes to the bylaws need to be presented to the membership at the Dec meeting, all to be voted on at the annual meeting on January 8, 2020.

An apparel order will be sent in after the January meeting. The order form is available on the website and at the meetings. If you plan to ride in the Pear Blossom Parade be sure and order your gold apparel.

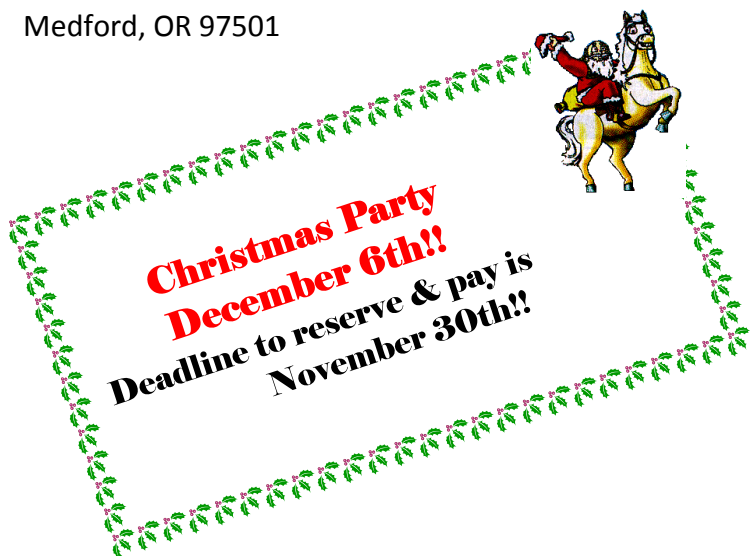
