Riding Beyond's mission is to enhance well-being of breast cancer survivors, their friends, families, associates, and others with life challenges through healing horse/human interactions. Riding Beyond is based in the Rogue Valley and began in 2013 with a gathering of people who recognized the life-changing benefits of a heart-to-heart relationship with horses for women experiencing the after-effects of breast cancer treatment. As it became clear that many friends and family members were unaware of their loved one's issues, they began to build wide-spread community awareness of the needs of breast cancer survivors and thrivers, as well as how a relationship with a horse as a sentient being can promote healing. They joined with those who participate in the medical profession's expansion from curing cancer to include wellness strategies post-treatment, through personal and conference presentations. After a couple of years of experience and learning, they began training professionals in equine assisted therapies around the world in the Riding Beyond model.



Come join us for a fun day riding your horse on the trails around Willow Prairie!! The marked trail will be about 3 hours long, but you can ride as long as your wish!

Camping:

We have reserved Group Camp Area B for Friday and Saturday nights, July 3 and 4th. There are several camping spaces (which will be shared). Overflow campers will be placed in the adjacent meadow. No reserves on specific campsites or corrals; first come – first choice. Corrals go fast, so plan to bring portable corrals or highline. The camp has vault toilets and a fresh water hand pump. Cost for camping is \$18 per night per family (i.e. - one truck/trailer combination). If you camp in the no reservation area to the left of the entrance you must pay the County Park camp fee of \$28/night (includes 1 vehicle) with maximum of 8 people per camp site. Please practice “Leave NO Trace” in camp areas, stalls and on trails. Come prepared to clean up after your horses (No one wants your left over manure or hay)! NOTE: Certified Weed Free Hay is NOT required at this camp.

Potluck:

Saturday afternoon at 12:30pm we will have a potluck at the sign up area. Please bring a **main dish** to share with the group. Bring a chair and beverages of your choice, no alcohol.

Raffle and Silent Auction:

You may purchase raffle tickets for \$5 for 10 tickets or \$2.00 a piece. Place them in the bucket of the prize you wish to win. Silent Auction items will be available all day for bidding. Drawing of raffle and winners of silent auction will be announced starting at 1pm

Lingo & Poker Ride:

Saturday July 4th Both of these events are on the same trail (You can participate in one or both events.) Lingo (aka Bingo) numbers are posted along the trail. Participants mark off the numbers on their cards. A blackout wins the money pot. If no blackout occurs, the card with the fewest numbers left wins. Ties will split the pot. Cards are \$5 each or 3 cards for \$12. One half of the money collected goes to the winner(s). The Poker Ride will run the same way. You will draw a 5-card hand. Highest hand and lowest hand will split the money. One hand is \$5 or 3 hands for \$12. Winners will be announced Saturday after silent auction / raffle is concluded or as soon as they are ready.

Rules:

- 1) No stallions allowed at the campout or in the events.
- 2) No dogs allowed on the event rides and per Jackson County Parks Rules- If you bring dogs to the campout they must be kept tied up in your camp or on a leash at all times for your dogs safety and for safety to others.
- 3) All children 17 years of age and younger are required to wear a safety helmet while riding in any event.
- 4) Heeled boots required for all riders for all events.
- 5) Riders under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult rider.
- 6) All club rules apply at this event along with the Inherent Risk Law of Oregon, ORS 30.689.
- 7) No alcohol during the ride.

Registration:

We are offering a discount for pre-registration. Fill out the form attached to this flyer, add up the total amount and subtract 10% if you are a non-club member or 20% if you belong to JCHA. Mail the completed form and check to: JCHA, PO Box 765, Medford, OR 97501 **MUST be received by June 26, 2026.** Request for cancellation refund **MUST be received by June 26, 2026.** **No refunds will be given after this date.**

Directions to Lily Glen:

The shortest route is to take I-5 south to Ashland exit 14. Head east on Dead Indian Memorial Hwy for about 17 miles, climbing up the steep, winding mountain then dropping down toward Howard Prairie Reservoir. Go past the turnoff to Howard Prairie Resort approx. 1/2 mile and watch for the camp on the right.

For an easier haul, but a few extra miles, take Hwy 140 from White City east towards Klamath Falls for 28 miles then turn onto FS Rd 37 - North Fork Campground Road. Follow it to the end (9 miles) and turn right on Dead Indian Memorial Hwy. Lily Glen is about 4 miles on the left.
